Hello Travelers and Caretakers,

As we move forward with activities we are taking extra precautions to ensure the safety of our travelers and staff. Please read and sign the following document.

Before you show up, please check the following:

- Have you had any of the following symptoms (fever of 100.4 °F or greater, cough, shortness of breath, diarrhea, fatigue, headache, muscle aches, nausea, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, vomiting, etc.) in the last 14 days?
- Have you traveled outside PA in the past 14 days? If so, where \_\_\_\_\_?
- Has the individual been in close contact with a person who has been diagnosed with, tested for, or quarantined as a result of COVID-19 in the past 14 days?

Procedures that we will be putting in place during the trip:

1. Check In:

- Drop off times will be staggered
- A sign off on this form for Covid-19 will be required before attending.
- Travelers must stay in their vehicle until called. Check-in will be outside.
- No touch thermometers will be used to take their temperature upon arrival.
- Once they are checked in, they can go into the building but must immediately wash their hands for 20 seconds. Once their hands are washed, they can continue into the activities room with everyone else.
- Caretakers cannot enter into the building.
- Vans will be wiped down with disinfectant before and after each use.

2. House/Rooms

- House will be cleaned and sanitized in its entirety before each group comes down.
- Handles and commonly touched surfaces will be wiped down daily
- Hand washing will be required as soon as they enter the house/room after coming in from any community outing.

3. Community Activities:

- Masks will be required for any indoor activities as well as outdoor activities when social distance is not feasible. Please provide your own mask and practice wearing it before the trip. We accept cloth masks and medical grade masks. There must be enough masks for the entire trip.
- We will social distance from other groups as best as we are able.

- We will use hand sanitizer after each activity, before eating (if unable to wash hands) and getting into the vans.

4. Hand Washing: When to Wash or Disinfect Hands

– Travelers and Staff

- Before and after eating food
- Upon entering the house/building/room
- After touching frequently touched surface
- After using the restroom
- After coughing, sneezing, or blowing your nose
- Before entering the van

5. Daily Covid screening will occur every morning:

- We will ask the individual if they have any COVID-19 symptoms (fever of 100.4 °F or greater, cough, shortness of breath, diarrhea, fatigue, headache, muscle aches, nausea, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, vomiting, etc.)
- We will check the temperature of the individual
- If the traveler or staff is suspected to have COVID-19 based on this assessment, we will place a face mask on the individual. We will Isolate the individual by separating them in a separate room. Staff will wear a face mask and disposable gloves while working with individuals who have a suspected case of COVID-19.
- We will contact parents/guardians immediately.
- We will meet parents/guardians halfway at 631 Mullica Hill Rd, Mullica Hill, NJ 08062 at a specified time. (for shore activities). A meeting location will be specified for the Dude Ranch.
- Other caregivers will be notified of possible COVID-19 contact.

We will be complying with all CDC and state health regulations during the trip. There is an inherent risk when entering the community during the pandemic. Although we will be taking every precaution, there is still a chance of illness. By attending this activity you agree to hold Compass Point Travel LLC., it's employees and all subsidiaries harmless.
